Information We Collect

We may collect personal information (name, email, phone, company), technical information (IP address, browser, device, cookies), and business information necessary to provide cybersecurity services.

How We Collect Information

Through contact forms, consultations, newsletters, email communications, job applications, events, cookies, analytics, contracts, and client onboarding.

Why We Collect Information

To provide services, respond to enquiries, improve our website, maintain security, process payments, comply with legal obligations, and communicate with clients.

Sharing Information

We do not sell personal information. Data may be shared only with trusted service providers, advisers, regulators, or authorities where legally required.

International Transfers

Where transfers occur outside the EEA, appropriate GDPR safeguards are implemented.

Security

We employ encryption, MFA, access controls, monitoring, vulnerability assessments, secure cloud infrastructure, backups, and staff awareness training.

Retention

We retain data only as long as necessary for legal, contractual, and operational purposes.
